## SPECIAL ACCESS TO AEROPLAN REWARD SEATS

Air Canada Elite members have access to unsold seats in Economy Class.

Reserve an Aeroplan Reward seat whenever you want — even when seats allocated for Aeroplan ClassicFlight™ Rewards are already completely booked. Whenever possible, your Aeroplan Reward reservation will be confirmed immediately.

- Double the Miles are required for ClassicFlight Rewards on all routes, except:
  - between Canada or the Continental U.S.A. and Europe (100,000 Aeroplan Miles required);
  - between Canada or the Continental U.S.A. and Asia, Tel-Aviv and Australia (130,000 Aeroplan Miles required)

## PRIORITY RESERVATION WAITLIST

As an Air Canada Elite member, you can ask to be put on the priority waitlist if you want a seat on a flight that is already booked to capacity.

Should someone cancel and a seat becomes available prior to the flight departure date, you will have top priority after Air Canada Super Elite members when available seats are assigned.

## PREFERRED SEAT SELECTION

You can request your preferred seat in Economy Class at the time of reservation.

## PRIORITY AIRPORT CHECK-IN

Present your Air Canada Elite card for Priority Airport Check-In at Air Canada Executive Class®/ Executive First® counters and spend less time in line.

This service is available when travelling on any fare, including Aeroplan Reward travel, during normal operations on scheduled flights operated by:

- Air Canada
- Air Canada Jazz
- Air Canada 4-digit flights operated by:
  - Air Georgian (doing business as Air Alliance)
  - Exploits Valley Air Services LTD
  - Central Mountain Air
- Star Alliance™ member airlines—just present your Air Canada Elite card at the business class or priority check-in counter designated by the Star Alliance Gold™ symbol at airports where this service is offered.

**Web Check-in** is available 24 hours prior to departure at [aircanada.com](http://aircanada.com) for Air Canada and Air Canada Jazz flights departing Canada to anywhere in the world—and to Canada from 18 U.S. cities and major international cities. If you have baggage to check, drop it off at the **Web Bag Drop-Off** position.

**Mobile Check-in** is now offered for Air Canada and Air Canada Jazz flights using your mobile device - cell phone, blackberry or TREQ. Log on to [mobile.aircanada.com](http://mobile.aircanada.com) using your mobile device. Complete your check-in on your mobile phone. At the airport, direct yourself to a Self-service kiosk (where available), or see an agent at the Air Canada counter to print your boarding pass.

You can also use Air Canada's **Self-service Check-in kiosks**, available at airports system-wide. Most kiosks are now equipped with passport readers to speed up check-in for U.S. passengers travelling on international flights. You can even make changes to your itinerary and pay the applicable fees through the kiosk. If you have baggage to check, drop it off at the **Baggage Drop-Off** position.

## PRIORITY AIRPORT STANDBY

Ask an agent at the airport to put you on standby for an earlier flight. As an Air Canada Elite member, you'll receive priority after Air Canada Super Elite members as seats become available.

Your fare and destination—for either a purchased ticket or an Aeroplan Reward ticket for same-day travel—must permit standby, during normal operations, for a scheduled flight operated by:

## EXTRA CHECKED BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Check up to four standard pieces of luggage—at no extra charge.

Each piece must weigh less than 70 lbs (32 kg). The total weight of all bags must not exceed 200 lbs (92 kg). This Privilege is available when travelling on any fare, including Aeroplan Reward travel, during normal operations on scheduled flights operated by:

- Air Canada
- Air Canada Jazz

Furthermore, when flying on any scheduled flight operated by a Star Alliance™ member airline during normal operations, you can bring either an additional 20 kg of luggage or one extra bag (for a total of three bags), depending on the carrier and route (one extra bag applies primarily on flights between North and South America).
